### Interim Musician

#### Requirements:

- Keyboard skills both organ and piano – proficient in leading congregational singing, as well as accompanying other musicians.
- Ability to organize and train choral and instrumental ensembles.

- Ability to organize choral and instrumental ensembles with children, youth and adults.
- Monthly planning with worship team.
